



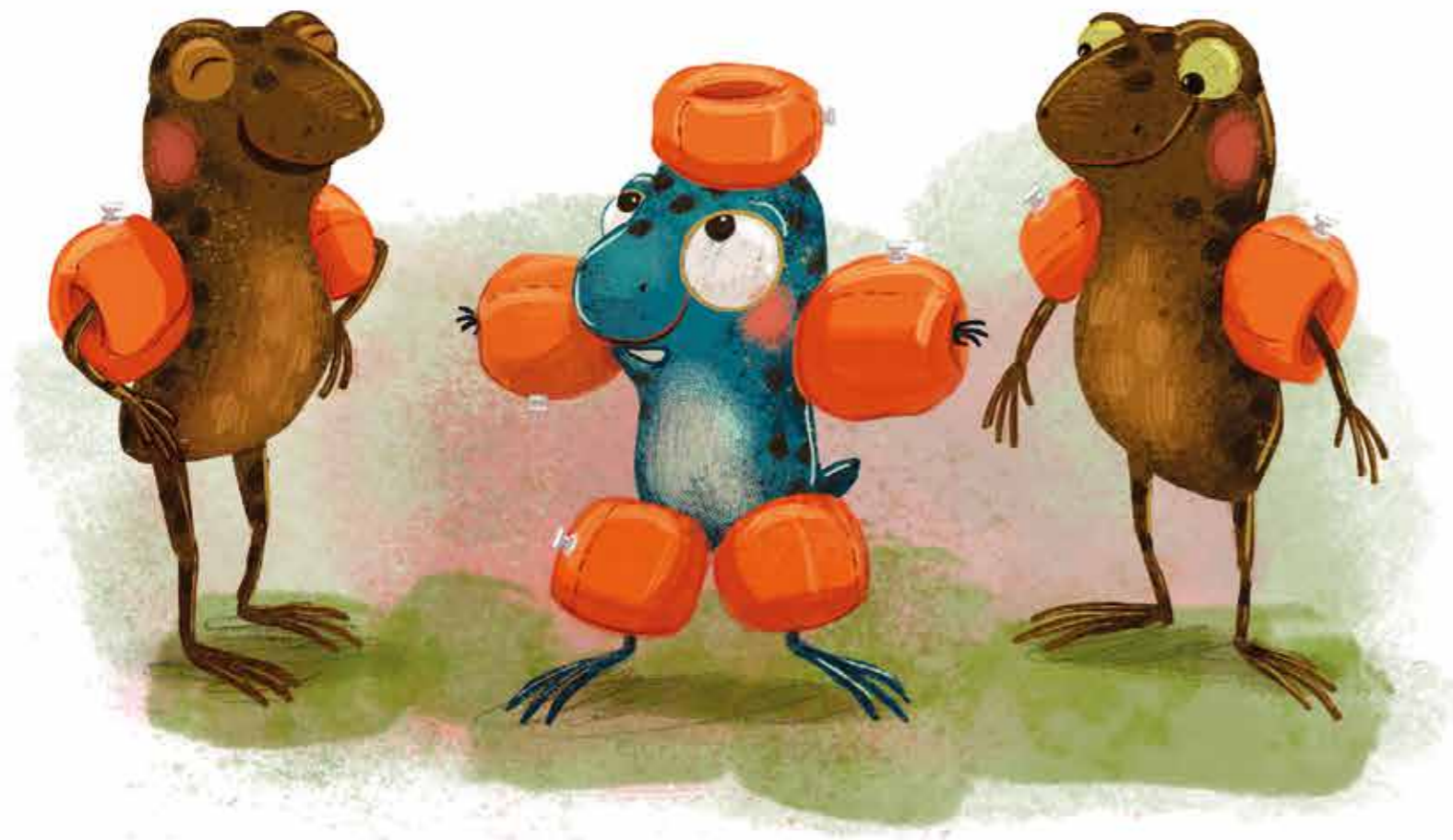
All the tadpoles in the pond
