"Yes, that's true,"  says. "I can't climb a  that high.

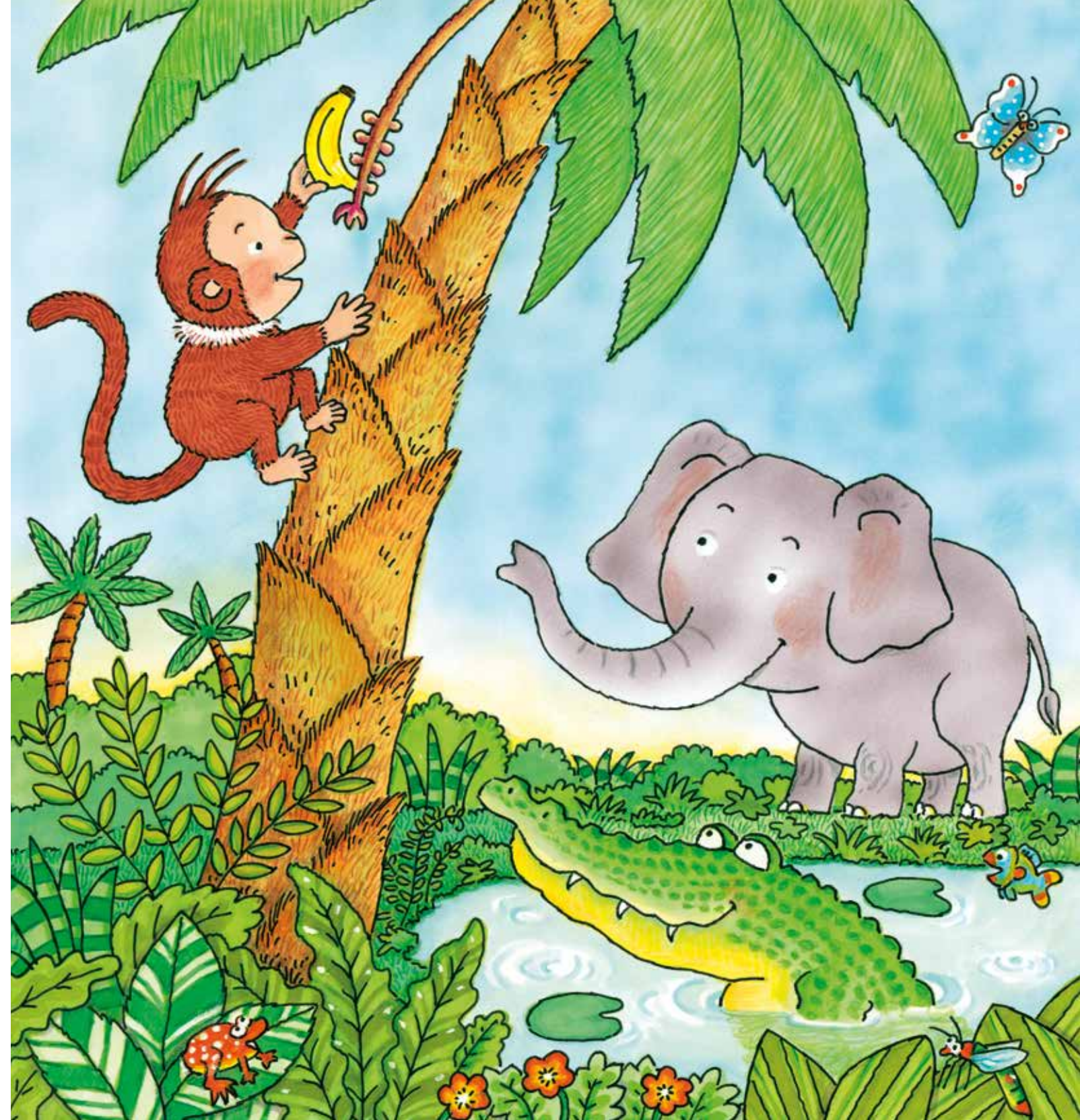
But I can swim, and that's why I can catch .
