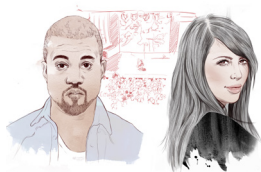




BARACK OBAMA & MICHELLE OBAMA

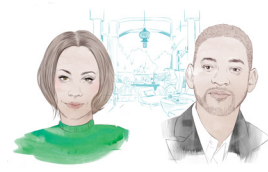
KANYE WEST & KIM KARDASHIAN

JOHN LEGEND & CHRISSEY TEIGEN

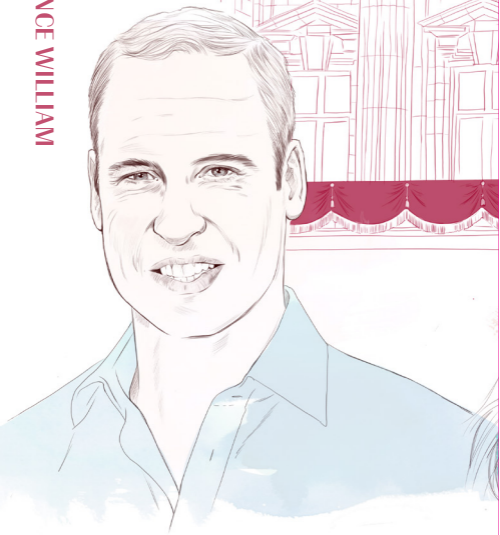

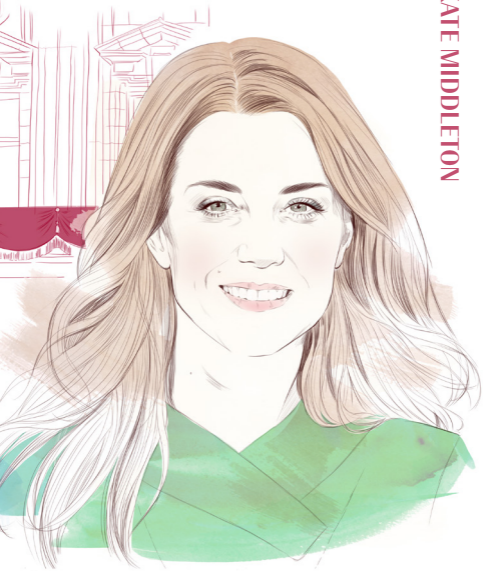
DAVID BECKHAM & VICTORIA BECKHAM
