
Grammar bovenbouw

Other Verbs in the Present Simple - Positive Sentences

Het onderwerp van de zin bepaalt hoe de werkwoordsvorm eruitziet. Het onderwerp vind je als antwoord op de vraag: wie 'doet' het?

Voorbeeld: Jan gaat op de fiets naar school. Jan 'doet' het, Jan is het onderwerp. We onderscheiden twee groepen onderwerpen:

- bij I, you, we en they blijft de werkwoordsvorm gelijk aan het hele werkwoord;
- bij he, she en it komt er een s achter het werkwoord (soms es: zie verderop).

to like I **like** ice cream. My brother (he) **likes** ice cream, too.

to run You **run** every day Mary (she) **run<u>s</u>** once a week. to eat We **eat** meat The dog (it) **eat** meat too.

to tell They **tell** jokes. Our teacher (he/she) always **tells** jokes.
