Preface

Presidential State Archives in Turkey, in Anatolia between the years 1910-1922 revealed that 523 thousand 955 Turks are massacred by Armenians. The massacres of the Armenian gangs were announced one by one with their dates, places and names.

Armenians were trying to attract world public opinion with alleged genocide allegations for years, official documents it shows that 523 thousand 955 Turks were killed in Anatolia between 1910 and 1922 by the Armenians.

Between 2000 and 2012, he was the General Manager of the Prime Ministry State Archives Prof. Dr. Yusuf Sarımay says: “When we face our history, we encounter our own losses and sufferings.”

Stating that Armenian gangs killed hundreds of thousands of Turks in Anatolia, Sarımay says: “Armenians could not form a majority in the land promised by the French, British and Russians to establish a state.

This was also voiced by major states. That is why they carried out systematic massacres in certain regions in order to form a majority.

The reason why the massacres are concentrated especially in Eastern Anatolia and Çukurova is that they have engaged in ethnic cleansing.

Those who saved their lives from the massacres also migrated from these regions. The purpose of the massacres is to realize the dream of the great Armenia. ”

Sarıay says that the losses are reflected in the documents in high amounts because the Armenian gangs sometimes massacred a few villages. Stating that every massacre is a document, Sarıay states that these are composed of the letters and reports submitted by the local administrators to the Istanbul government and the minutes prepared by foreign observers.
