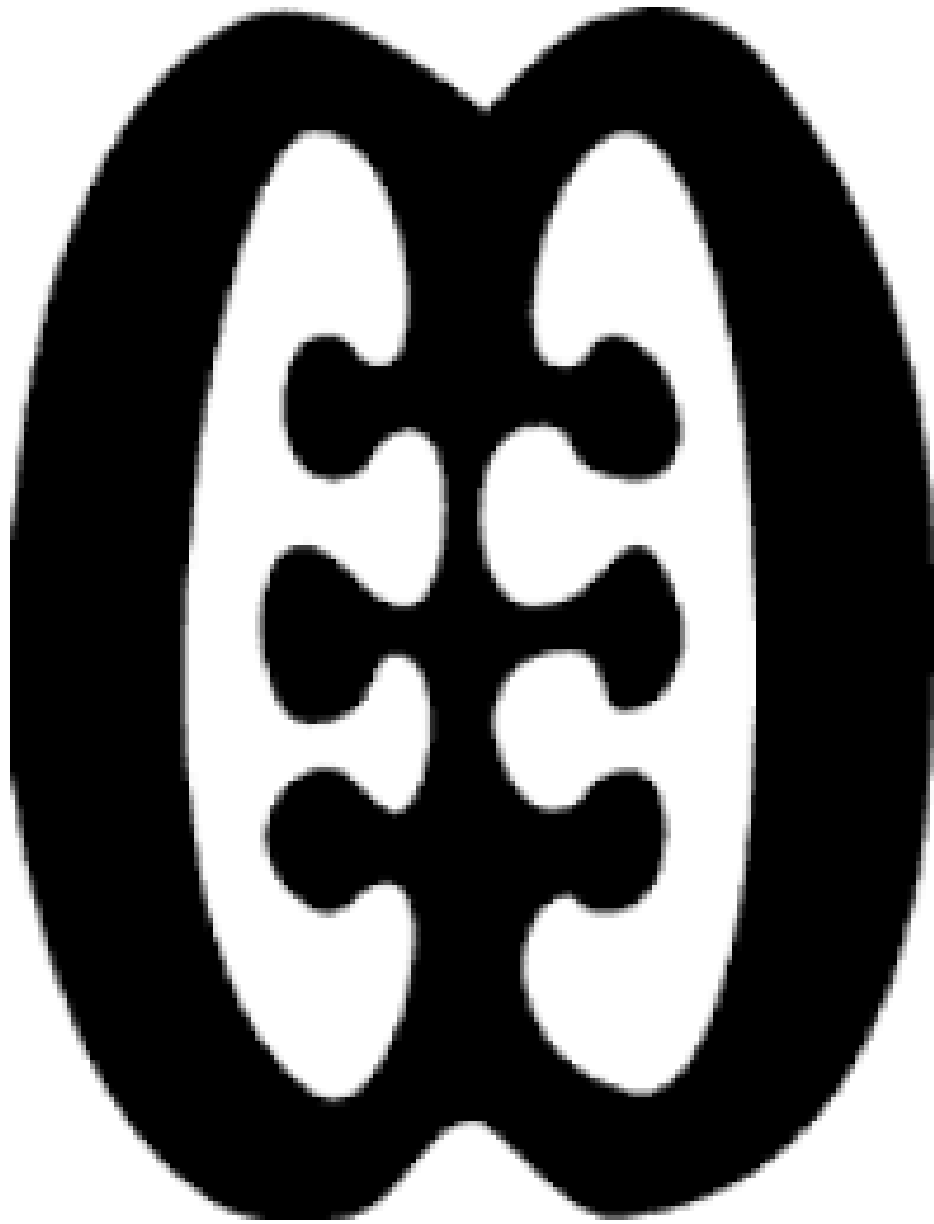

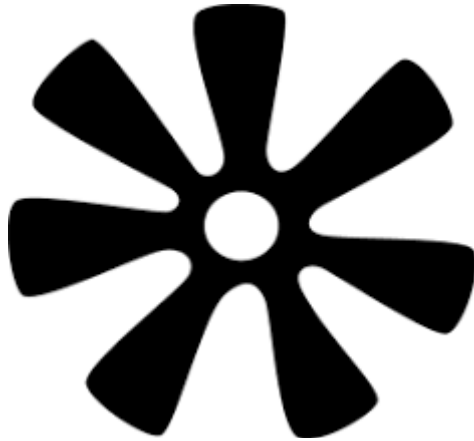

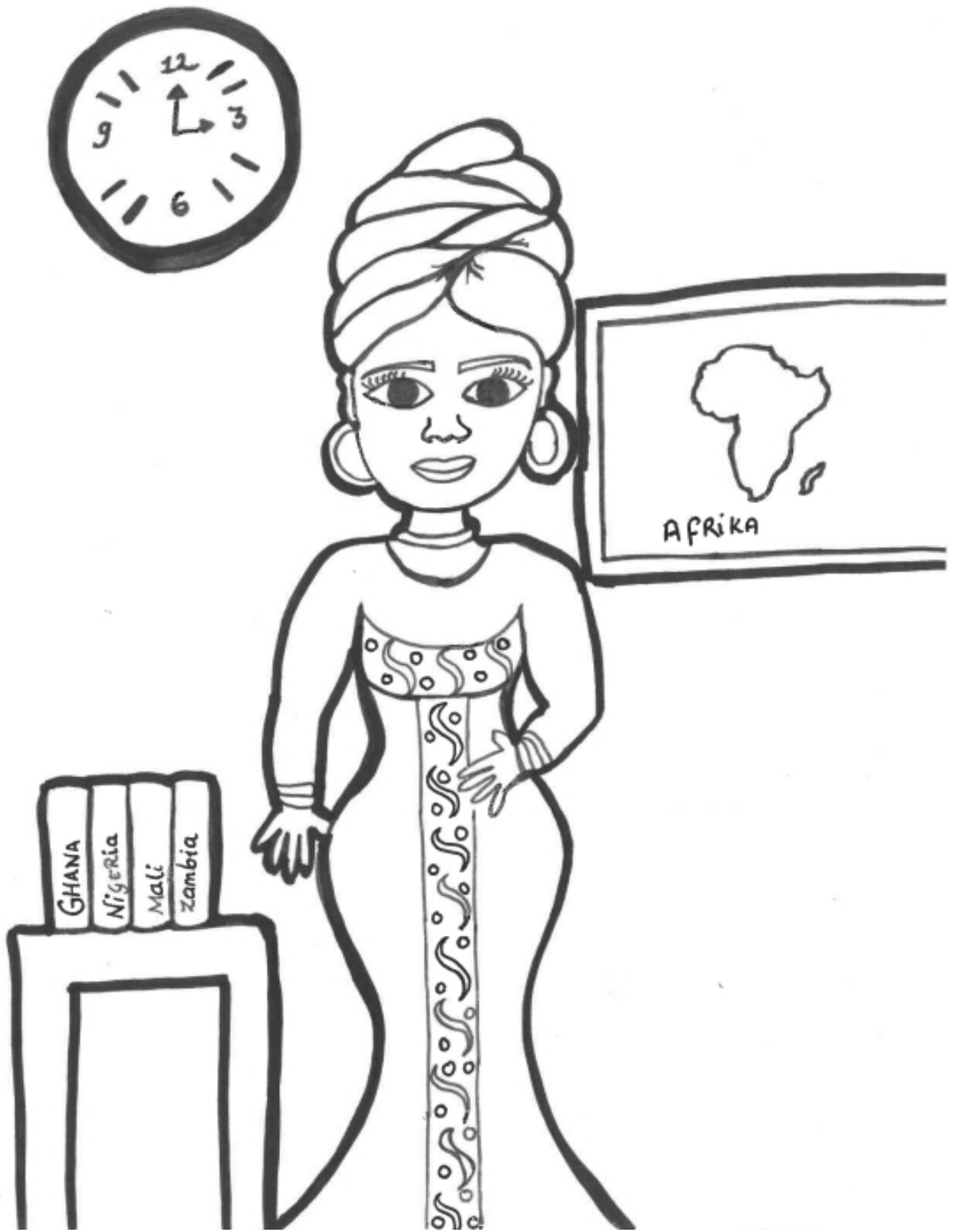


Anansi spider web
