New International Version For I know the plans I have for you," declares the LORD, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.

New Living Translation

For I know the plans I have for you," says the LORD. "They are plans for good and not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope.

English Standard Version

For I know the plans I have for you, declares the LORD, plans for welfare and not for evil, to give you a future and a hope.

This word peace is a Hebrew word '*shalom*', which in short means nothing missing, nothing lacking. But here is its definition: peace, harmony, wholeness, completeness, tranquillity, perfect health, safety, welfare, prosperity and is also used to say hello or goodbye.

7-Tips to walk in Peace

- 1. Start and end your day with at least one scripture
- 2. Speak in tongues even for 5-minutes
- 3. Take a moment to check in with Holy Spirit
- 4. Forgive super quickly
- 5. Set your alarm to have a laugh session for at least 1- minute
- 6. Bless the Lord during the day for even 1-minute
- 7. Take a moment for yourself
