Two signs produced the most presidents.

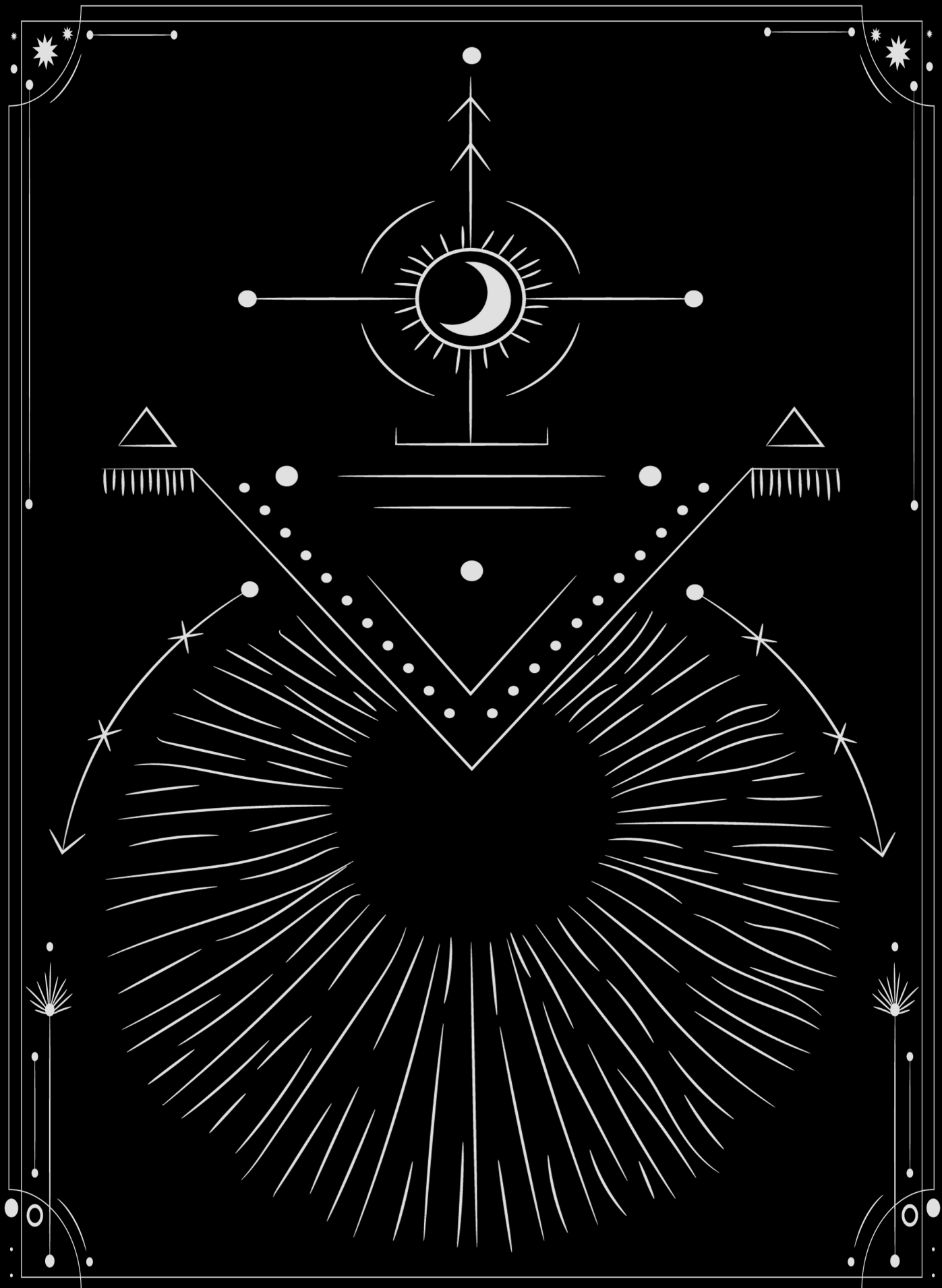

0 Tarot – The Fool Card

The Fool card may be numbered either 0 or XXII or may be unnumbered in Tarot decks designed for traditional card games.

In Tarot card reading, the Fool card symbolizes new beginnings, fresh starts, and taking a leap of faith. It encourages individuals to let go of fears and doubts and embrace the unknown with open-mindedness and optimism. The card also represents the idea of living in the moment and enjoying life to its fullest potential. When drawn in a reading, the Fool card can indicate opportunities for adventure, risk-taking, and personal growth.

If the Fool card appears in a reversed position during a Tarot reading, it may suggest that an individual is acting recklessly or impulsively without considering the consequences of their actions. It may also indicate that one is not taking responsibility for their actions and blaming others for their mistakes. Thoth Tarot deck

Thoth Tarot Deck is the One of the most famous decks in the world, drawn by a mystical scholar who is also a member of the Golden Dawn, the legendary Aleister Crowley. In spite of being one of the classic decks, Thoth Tarot contains the mystical Kabbalah symbolic systems and astrology from The Book of Thoth, requiring users to have a certain background to be able to capture the best.
