




SUGGESTIONS TO ENJOY THE EXPERIENCE FROM THIS BOOK

- 7 | In your life, think inside the box, and judiciously choose the places to put the mind and thoughts you have hidden in your heart.




If you were a superhero, what would your superpower be?






If you were a color, what color would you be?






Choose the three letters you like the most.






If you could offer a gift to God, what gift would it be?






If you had to give a letter to your best friend, which one would it be?






What is your favorite word?






What are the three words you like the most?






What are the three words you like the least?








What is your favorite letter?










What is the number you like the least?






