Introduction

Over the next 21 days, you'll reflect on Scriptures about love, take on daily assignments to express or receive love, and receive encouragement to grow in your relationship with God and others. By the end of this journey, may you feel more rooted in His love, more open to loving others, and more confident in sharing His love with the world.

How to use this Journal:

Make it a time special to you because you are investing in yourself; this can be any time. Consistency is key, whether it's in the morning to start your day, during a quiet lunch break, or in the evening before bed, at a time convenient to you.

Ask the Holy Spirit to guide and help you, open your heart, and let God reveal His love in a fresh way.

This Journal contains a reading, meditation, and a writing section.

The bible verse of the day is to read and meditate upon. The assignment includes a practical assignment to help you live out the message of love. These activities range from simple reflections to tangible acts.

The 'Speak' section is to be spoken aloud; if there are dotted lines, you can place your name on it. In the prayer section, you also need to speak out because faith comes by hearing and hearing the word of God. The encouragement plus quotes are to think about and reflect upon.

There are journaling pages where you can write down your thoughts and reflect on how the day's theme applies to your life. Journaling helps solidify what you're learning and creates a record of your journey to look back on.

Not every day will look the same, and that's okay. If you miss a day, don't be discouraged—just pick up where you left off. The goal is growth, not perfection. Allow God's love to shape you day by day.

Verse to Read: John 3:16

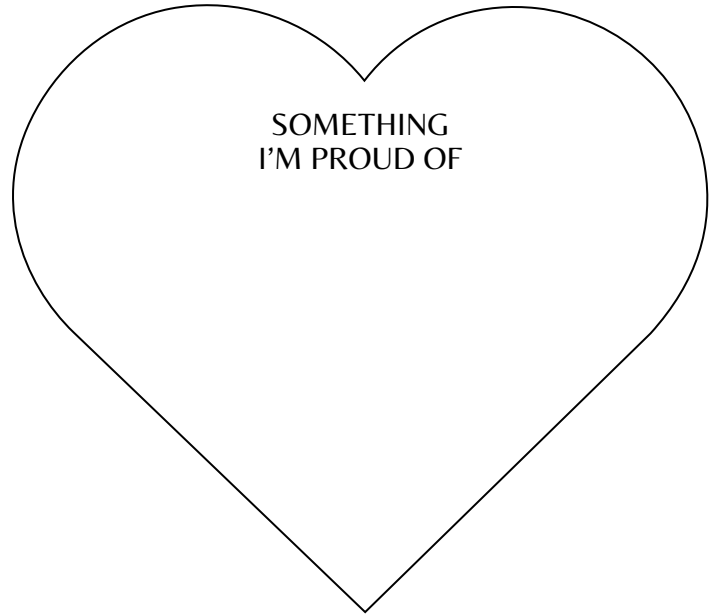

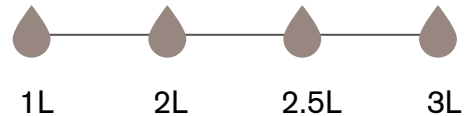
