Over the past three years, we have successfully built a vast and reliable intelligence network that now includes over 50 sources, many of whom are embedded close to the Taliban and Al-Qaeda leadership.

This network has provided us with unparalleled access to information that is both credible and detailed. By adhering to the principle of “one source = no source,” we have meticulously cross verified every piece of intelligence, ensuring its accuracy before drawing any conclusions. This rigorous approach has allowed us to compile a comprehensive picture of Al-Qaeda’s current activities, strategies, and, most alarmingly, its plans for future attacks.

The intelligence gathered points to a chilling and imminent threat intended to surpass the horrors of 9/11. This threat compels us to write this book and share our findings. We hope that our insights will help raise awareness, encourage preparedness, and ultimately contribute to a safer world.

The fight against terrorism is far from over, more than ever, it requires the vigilance and cooperation of all who value peace and security.
