
WHAT IF YOUR TONGUE WAS THAT LONG?

Giant anteaters love fresh ants. With their sticky, two-foot-long tongues, they can reach deep into an ant nest.


No ant is safe when a giant anteater starts snacking. They can eat up to 30,000 ants a day!
